Message from Our Pastor

John the Baptist will be the unique announcer of the public appearance of Jesus the Messiah. The relationship of the two is tied to the special relationship between their mothers.

EXEGESIS:

When the expectant Elizabeth meets her expectant cousin, Mary, the former is moved by the Holy Spirit to greet the latter with great joy. Elizabeth acts much like angel Gabriel who first greeted Our Lady, as she provides us with the additional words for the opening of the traditional "Hail, Mary" prayer. Thus Luke is the first evangelist to identify Jesus as the Lord even before Jesus' birth, and he again presents John the Baptist as the forerunner of the Christ Messiah.
