Dear Parishioners of Saints Cyril and Methodius,

On April 1, 2014, I was appointed as Pastor of Saints Cyril and Methodius Parish for a period of six years by His Excellency Bishop Joe Vásquez. I am truly grateful for this assignment, and I look forward to undertaking the pastoral care of you, the parishioners. I also thank Father Nesrsta for his excellent oversight of the Parish during his tenure this past year or so.

As I dedicate myself to this new assignment, I will do my best, with the help of Our Lord, to fulfill my responsibilities and to be a good shepherd to you.
