Message from Our Pastor

Today's short gospel opens the season of Advent and the new Church year. It sets the tone for Advent: penance and preparation for death and the end of time, not only preparation for the Nativity. As such, Advent looks to both the past (the Incarnation of the Son of God in Bethlehem) and the future (the ultimate judgment and reign of Christ). For the new year, the Church now changes its Sunday gospel readings from Matthew to Mark.

EXEGESIS:

Jesus admonishes his listeners to be constantly alert and watchful for death, punishment, and destruction, just as servants and keepers (Christians) of their master's house must be responsible and watchful in guarding the house (the Church). Jesus can also be referring to his own return to life at his resurrection after his terrible suffering on the cross. And Mark, writing his gospel around the time of the destruction of Jerusalem by the pagan Romans in 70 A.D., can be referring to this terrible event in which both Christians and Jews suffered greatly.

In the old Latin funeral Mass and in some of the liturgies during Advent before the Vatican Council II, the Latin hymn, "Dies Irae" ("O Day of Wrath"), was common. Its somber tone and lyrics describing death and judgment highlighted this Church season.
