In-Pew Collection May 13-14: The completion of the Trinity Dome in preparation for the 100th anniversary of the laying of the foundation stone of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC in 2020 is a monumental undertaking for which the Bishops of the United States have approved a special one-time second collection to take place in-pew on Mother's Day 2017. The Basilica also known as America's Catholic Church, the National Shrine has been a century in the making, built by and for the faithful of our great nation in honor of our Blessed Mother, the patroness of the United States. This collection will provide the faithful with an opportunity to contribute to the legacy begun by their ancestors, to include honoring their Catholic heritage and entrusting themselves and their families to the Mother of God. Funds for the completion of the Trinity Dome will be raised primarily through this national collection.
