Clarence Selucky, George Strmiska, Kathy Janke, John Simcik will be going off the Council December 31, 2018.

We will be selecting four new members so that we have a total of eleven members on the Council. Please make your nominations on the form below. Only one set of nominations per parishioner and the ballot must be signed by the person making the nominations. All nominees must be registered parishioners, contributing members of Ss. Cyril & Methodius Catholic Church, Catholics in good standing with the Church, and EIM compliant upon acceptance to the Council. Please take a moment to fill out the form and return it to the parish office, or mail it, or put it in the collection basket.

All nominations must be turned in by Sunday, September 16. All Ballots must be signed by person submitting. Once all the names have been collected we will determine if they meet the qualifications and the persons will be contacted to see if they are willing to serve on the Council. Names of qualified nominees will be placed in a drawing box, the Council will pray for guidance from the Holy Spirit and four names will be drawn. This selection process will take place at a called Pastoral Council meeting once we have verified the nominations.
